She discussed under and over steering and how to keep your car in control during skids. Topics were presented with very creative graphics drawn by Ms. Schottland. She is also an artist and depicts many of her scenarios in some incredibly unique illustrations. The mission of her company, DriveLab, is to reduce the number of deaths and accidents by making drivers understand why a vehicle does what it does, to prevent the unspeakable from happening and how to deal with it when and if it does happen.

Participants were treated to a table full of delectable deserts and gift bags. Milwaukee Frozen Custard, Allure spa and Moe's Southwest grill donated some items for many giveaways. Participants volunteered lots of feedback, mostly in appreciation of the relaxed atmosphere and that the "class was entertaining and very informative".
